

Signage Policy - Alstonefield Parish Council (APC)

1. APC will seek Highways Authority permission for the erection of any signs.
2. APC will seek Highways Authority permission for the removal of any signs.
3. The work of APC sign erection or removal must be organised and carried out by the Highways Authority.
4. APC policy is to signpost community buildings and areas where appropriate and at the discretion of APC (e.g. Church, play area). APC will cover the cost of such signage.
5. Whilst it is not our policy to signpost individual businesses, APC will uphold agreements made in the past with certain businesses, as long as those businesses are in existence. However, continued signage is totally at the discretion of APC, and businesses are not required to make any further financial contribution. Should businesses cease to exist, APC will organise for the removal of signage.
6. Those businesses covered by previous agreements (as noted in paragraph 5) are not required to make any further financial contribution.
7. Should such businesses cease to exist or permanently close their doors to the general public, APC will organise for the removal of signage.
8. APC are responsible for the maintenance of APC signage. Organisations and businesses affected will be informed if signage is to be removed for maintenance and/or health and safety reasons.
