Conditions of Entry

Start Time 09.00 for all

From Alstonefield Village Hall (GR SK130557)

1. **The challenge is to complete the 26.2-mile event within 12 hours.**
2. **Registration starts at 07.30 hours for all.**
3. **Entry is limited to 330 entrants.**
4. **On the day entrants might be accepted up to the 330-entry limit.**
5. **To conform to guidelines published the LDWA, UKA and HSE, a minimum age for those walking is 14-years, whilst for runners the minimum age is 18-years. Under 15-year old entrants must be accompanied by a parent or a responsible adult throughout the event.**
6. **Entrants who wish to retire MUST attempt to do so at checkpoints.**
7. **Entrants arriving at a checkpoint after its closing time, or deemed to be unlikely to reach the next checkpoint before its closing time will be advised to retire.**
8. **Lifts will be arranged back to the Alstonefield Village Hall for retirees.**
9. **A list of checkpoint closing times will be supplied in the final details.**
10. **Walkers / runners should have attained a suitable level of fitness to undertake this challenge, and carry suitable clothing and equipment (for example compass, whistle, first aid, waterproofs etc). Re-hydration liquids and food should be carried to maintain their safety and comfort for the duration of the event.**
11. **Entrants should carry and refer to O.S Explorer Map OL 24, 'The WhitePeak'. The route description is based on this map.**
12. **Dog owners must be responsible for their dogs at all times.**
13. **The Leaden Boot Challenge route traverses paths, trails or open access land. It does not crossover unapproved farm property. Please stick to paths.**
14. **The route follows some minor roads; please take great care along these sections.**
15. **The entrance fee will be refunded for cancellations before 1st May 2019 subject to a five pound deduction for administration.**
16. **The organisers reserve the right to incorporate/change rules as they deem necessary even to having to cancel the event in extraordinary circumstances. Their decision will be final.**
