## Eleanor McEvoy

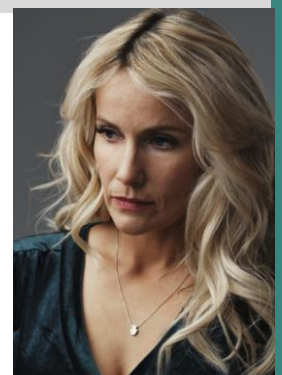
