- (a) Higher charges apply to private bookings made by individuals not living in the Alstonefield parish and commercial bookings such as antiques fairs or commercial activities providing only incidental benefit to the local community.
- (b) Charges include heating, hot water and use of facilities in the kitchen or Meeting room kitchenette to make basic refreshments (tea/coffee/soft drinks etc). If tea towels provided by the Hall are used, these must be taken away and returned after cleaning.
- (c) Reduced charges may be agreed at the Committee's discretion for:
 - i. regular hire, where advance bookings are made for a minimum of 12 morning, afternoon or evening sessions; and
 - ii. local user groups (such as Parent & Toddlers) eligible to be represented as member trustees on the Village Hall Committee, if standard charges are not affordable to the particular group.
- (d) Any reduction from the standard charges is limited to 12 months, after which it is subject to review. The committee will seek to ensure fairness and consistency in applying any reduction in charges, whilst giving priority to not-for-profit activities run by local people for the community.
- (e) Time needed for setting-up in advance of the hire period, making the main hall unavailable for other bookings, and time needed for cleaning/tidying afterwards, is chargeable at 50% of standard charges¹ unless there is full use of the kitchen during the set-up period, when full charges apply. If set-up makes the main hall unavailable on Saturday evenings, the 50% deduction applies to the 'social events' rate.

 (¹ less any reduction for regular/user group hire that has been agreed)
- (f) Full use of the kitchen when hiring the main hall includes use of the crockery, utensils and all equipment including kettles, cooker, dishwasher, Lincat boiler, dishwasher, hot cabinets, etc. Hire of the kitchen only (without use of the main hall) is subject to individual agreement.
- (g) The adjoining Old School Garden may be reserved for private use when hiring any part of the premises (charge negotiable).
- (h) For charitable fund-raising or community support activities (e.g. emergency responders), a donation to cover costs may be accepted, rather than the standard hire charge, by individual agreement depending the nature of the event and facilities used.
- (i) Unless hiring the whole Hall, hirers should be aware that others may be using part of the premises.
- (j) The above is only a guide charges can be varied or tailored according to circumstances and are at the Booking Officer or Committee's discretion.
